

# Reunion August 2001

## **REGISTER NOW – ACCOMODATION IS LIMITED**

**Anzac Day** has now passed so the next major event for us is the long awaited **2001 reunion**.

The reunion is only **10 weeks** away, so far we only have **52 registered** (plus partners), if you are coming *your registration is extremely important*, even if you are not staying at the venue, the deadline is **June 30th**. We need definite numbers for catering and transport requirements. ## Reunion Itinerary

You will need to find your own way from the airport to the hotel, shuttle buses and taxis are available. You can book in to your room at any time.

Registration will commence at **1500hrs** onwards at the **Grand Chancellor Hotel** (Wellington St), in the **Green Room**, on Friday the 17<sup>th</sup>. Signs will be in the foyer or ask at reception.

Fellowship will commence at **1700hrs** onwards at the **Grand Chancellor Hotel**, in the **Green Room**, again signs will be in the foyer or ask at reception.

On Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup> breakfast is your choice. The AGM will commence at **1000hrs** in the **Green Room**, at this time a new committee will be elected and the State for our next reunion chosen, so give it some thought as to where you would like it to be and if it is in your State, are you willing to take on a position.

Also at **1000hrs** the ladies will depart from the front of the hotel in buses for a tour of the City, down to Fremantle and then back to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Kings Park at **1200hrs** for the afternoons proceedings.

At **1130hrs** buses will leave the front of the hotel for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Kings Park, take/wear your jacket and medals as the service follows, for a BBQ lunch and refreshments in the beautiful surroundings of the Kings Park bushland.

The Vietnam Veterans Day service commences at **1430hrs** with all marchers moving of to the form up point, we will fall in behind the association banner. The parade will move off to the memorial (about 300metres) for the service, which will last for 45 minutes approximately.

On completion of the service buses will take us to the Forrest Tavern (licensee Peter Northwood ex 6RAR) in St Georges Tce for fellowship, a sausage sizzle will be available or back to the hotel for those who want to get changed etc. It is a 3 block walk back to the Tavern. This will be an open affair with veterans from other groups in attendance.

Sunday morning the 19<sup>th</sup> will be free/recovery time until **1100hrs** when buses will leave from the front of the hotel (if you are staying elsewhere there is ample parking opposite the Grand Chancellor) and take us to the Mends St jetty in South Perth for the formal part of our reunion. This will be a cruise on the Paddle Steamer, Decoy departing at **1200hrs** down the beautiful Swan River to Fremantle and return, light finger foods will be available on departure, followed by lunch which will be provided as follows (subject to change):

**Bread Rolls and Butter**

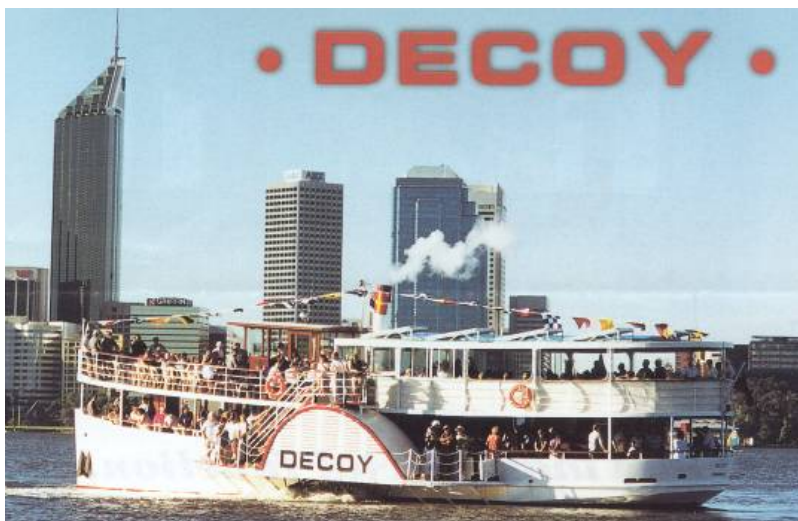
**Seasonal Fruit Platter**
